- Top pay for UPS drivers in this market is almost \$30/hr
- Top pay for FedEx Couriers in this market is almost \$22/hr
- Progression (time to reach top pay) for a UPS Driver takes three years.
- Progression (time to reach top pay) for a FedEx Courier takes over fifteen years.
- Benefits (health, dental and vision) for a spouse and children can cost a FedEx Courier almost \$300 per month.
- Benefits (health, dental and vision) for a spouse and children cost a UPS Driver \$0 per month.
- UPS Drivers receive two paid 15 min breaks per day.
- FedEx Couriers do not receive paid breaks.
- UPS Drivers are guaranteed raises twice per year.
- FedEx Couriers are not guaranteed raises.
- UPS offers a traditional pension plan.
- FedEx offers a nontraditional “portable” pension plan.
- UPS Drivers receive incentive pay for beating a route plan.
- FedEx Couriers are not compensated for beating a route plan.
